

Apple Macintosh ftp upload guide

We have produced this guided walkthrough to aid you in uploading files to us via our ftp server. Every care has been taken to produce an accurate representation of the process involved. For this example we will assume that you have downloaded Fetch and have installed it according to the software manufacturer. We also assume that you can upload via the ftp protocol either through a corporate firewall or a standard internet modem or router. In some cases it may be necessary for your IT/Network administrator to allow ftp uploads through the corporate firewall.

1. Launch Fetch



2. This will launch the New Connection window:



Enter the details as follows:

Hostname: 80.176.192.25

Username: (This will have been supplied to you via an email)

Connect using: FTP

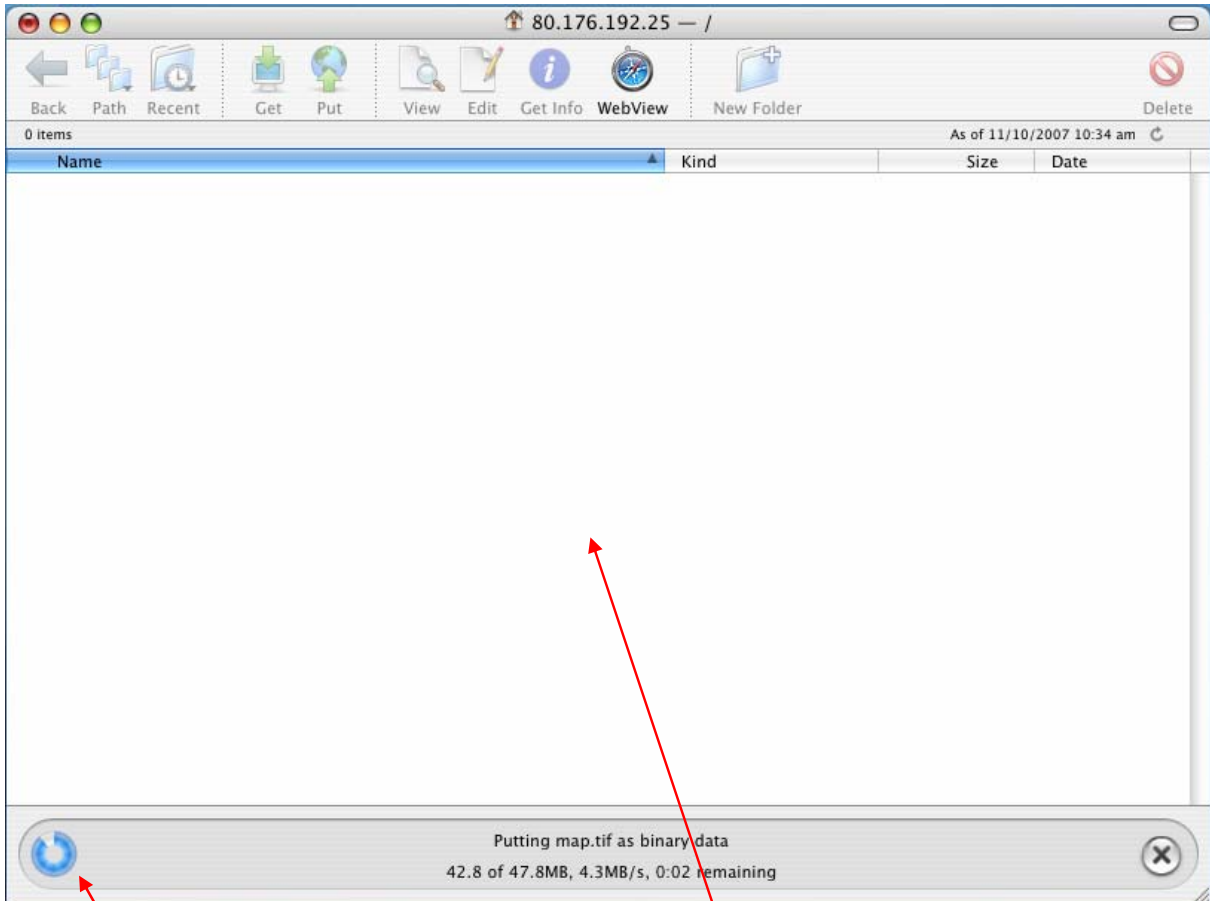
Password: (This will have been supplied to you via an email)

Once you have entered your details all you have to do is press the Connect button; this will log you in to our ftp server.

3. After a few seconds you should get the following screen:



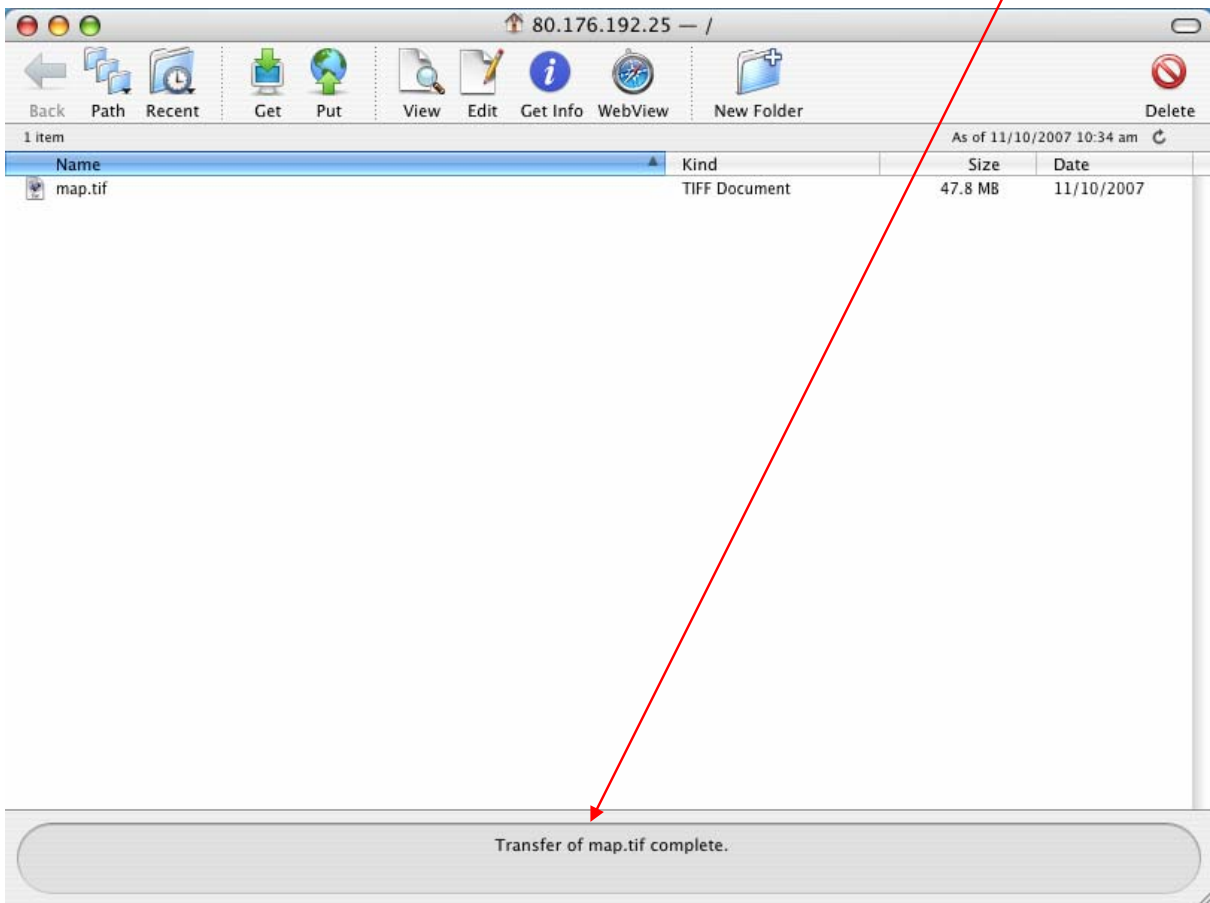
To upload a file or files to us you simply drag files into here.

You will get a progress indicator in the bottom left as shown in the above screenshot.

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Once the files that you are uploading have finished they will be displayed as below. You will also get confirmation that the file has transferred correctly at the bottom of Fetch.



If you have more files to upload then simply dragging them into the main Fetch window will start another transfer.

Once you have finished uploading all of your files simply quit Fetch.

And that's it.
